1.1 General information





Test standard

AS/NZS 2007.1:2021; AS/NZS 2007.2:2021; AS/NZS 6400:2016

AdoraDish V6000 models (AS6T...)

The appliances are equipped with a water tank. For hygiene reasons, the tank is automatically emptied 36 hours after being filled. The tank is filled only on the third programme if twice in a row the waiting time between programmes is less than 36 hours. To ensure the tank is full, the following must be carried out before conducting the test:

Applies to all AdoraDish V6000 models:


- ▶ Add the detergent.
- ▶ Run the «Intensive»  programme.
 - Manufacturing residues are removed during the wash cycle.
- ▶ Run the «Pre-rinsing»  programme.
- ▶ Run the «Eco»  programme.
- ▶ When the «Eco»  programme ends, disconnect the appliance from the mains power supply.

These three programmes should be run on one and the same day. The test can be started the next day. After waiting for a period of about 12 hours, it can be ensured model AS6T-41121 (with heat pump) has reached room temperature.

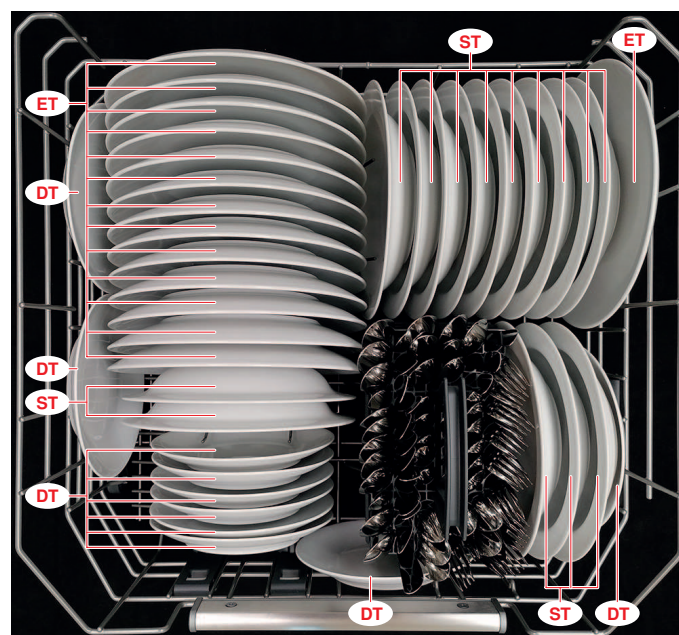
Drying measurements

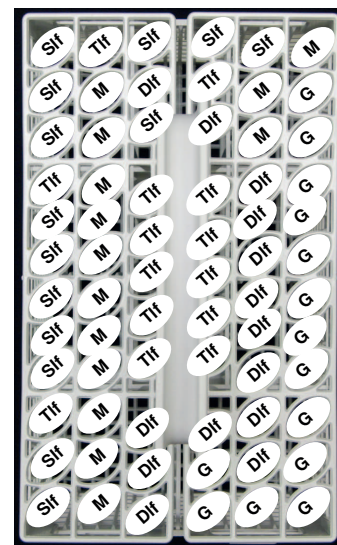
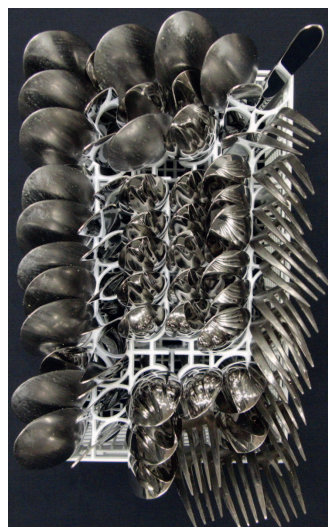

Cutlery basket

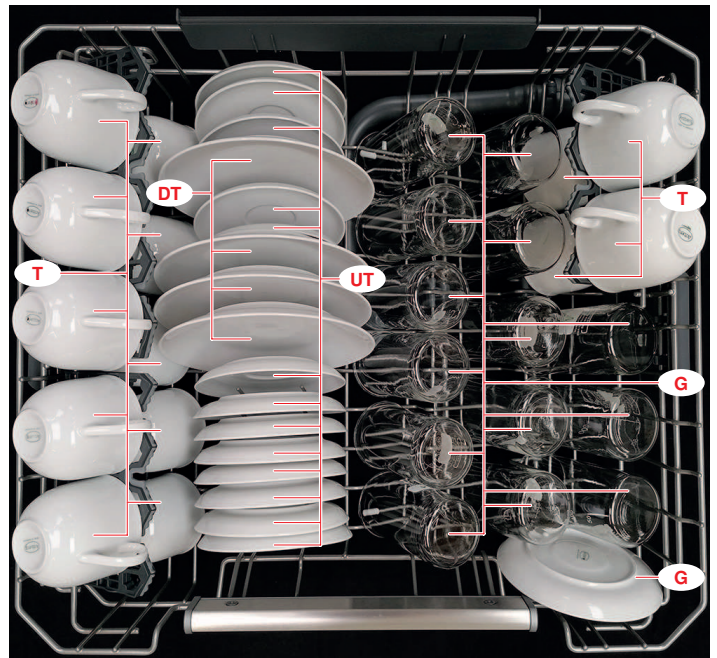

DT	4	dessert plates

- Position the plates so that the spinach is at the top.



- Push the cups on the racks in the corners as far inwards as possible.



- Lower the basket right down.
- Remove the small-parts holder (if any).
- Remove racks that are not being used.
- The cups **T** on the rack must lie against the rack cam and not lie against the basket.
- Rest the cups **T** not sitting on the rack with their handles up against the wires of the basket.



- Place the foremost saucer right at the front.




- **AS2T** appliances come with glass holders **1 and 2**.
- **AS6T** appliances come with glass holders **1–4**.
- Fold up glass holders **1 and 2** and fold down glass holders **3 and 4**.

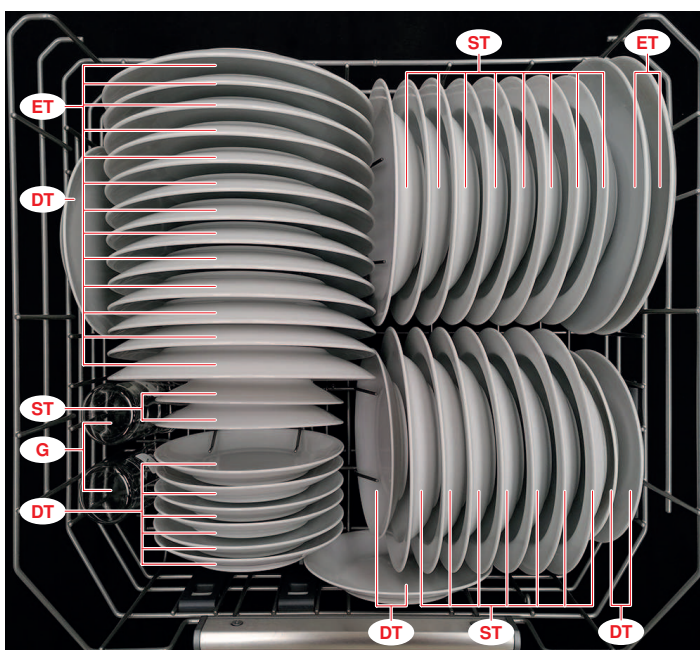

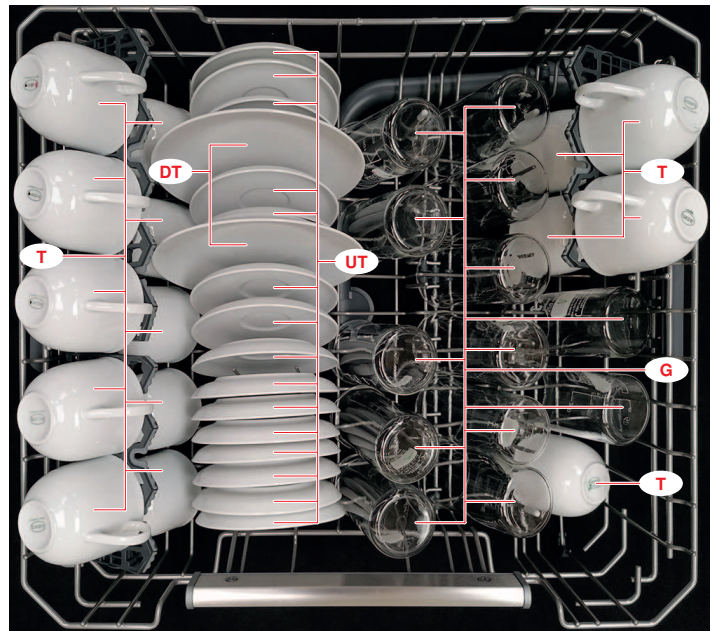

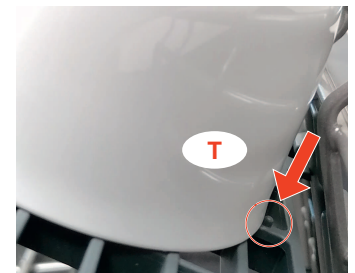
- Position the plates so that the spinach is at the top.

- Lower the basket right down.
- Remove the small-parts holder (if any).
- Remove racks that are not being used.
- The cups **T** on the rack must lie against the rack cam and not lie against the basket.
- Rest the cups **T** not sitting on the rack with their handles up against the wires of the basket.



- Place the foremost saucer right at the front.



- Fold up all glass holders **1–4**.

- Arrange cutlery slightly diagonally (see image).
 ► Carefully push in the cutlery drawer and make sure it does not collide with the cups.
